## A BILL

To provide for the expedited procurement of equipment needed to combat COVID-19 under the Defense Production Act of 1950.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. EXPEDITED PROCUREMENT OF EQUIPMENT 4 NEEDED TO COMBAT COVID-19.

(a) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than 7 days after
the date of the enactment of this Act, the National Response Coordination Center of the Federal Emergency
Management Agency, in coordination with the Defense
Logistics Agency and in consultation with the Department

of Health and Human Services, shall submit to Congress
 and the President a report that includes—

3 (1) an assessment of the need across the United
4 States for equipment necessary to prevent, identify,
5 and mitigate cases of coronavirus disease 2019
6 (commonly known as "COVID-19"), including per7 sonal protective equipment and ventilators;

8 (2) an identification of the industry sectors and
9 manufacturers most ready to fulfill purchase orders
10 for such equipment; and

(3) an identification of government and privately owned stockpiles of equipment not included in
the Strategic National Stockpile that could be repaired or refurbished.

15 (b) PURCHASE ORDERS.—

16 (1) IMMEDIATE PURCHASES.—Not later than
17 24 hours after the enactment of this Act, the Presi18 dent shall issue a "DX" rated priority purchase
19 order pursuant to Department of Defense Directive
20 4400.1 to procure 300,000,000 N95 respirators and
21 facemasks under authorities provided by the Defense
22 Production Act of 1950 (50 U.S.C. 4501 et seq.).

23 (2) ADDITIONAL PURCHASES.—Not later than 7
24 days after receiving the report required by sub25 section (a), the President shall issue "DX" rated

priority purchase orders pursuant to Department of
 Defense Directive 4400.1 to procure equipment iden tified under paragraph (1) of that subsection under
 authorities provided by the Defense Production Act
 of 1950 (50 U.S.C. 4501 et seq.).

6 (c) WAIVER OF CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS.—The re7 quirements of sections 301(d)(1)(A), 302(d)(1), and sub8 paragraphs (B) and (C) of section 303(a)(6) of the De9 fense Production Act of 1950 (50 U.S.C. 4531(d)(1)(A),
10 4532(d)(1), and 4533(a)(6)) are waived for purposes of
11 this section.

(d) FUNDING.—Amounts available in the Defense
Production Act Fund under section 304 of the Defense
Production Act of 1950 (50 U.S.C. 4534) shall be available for purchases made under this section.
