- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Augmenting Research
- 5 and Educational Sites to Ensure Agriculture Remains
- 6 Cutting-Edge and Helpful Act" or the "AG RESEARCH

- 8 SEC. 2. AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH FACILITIES.
- 9 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds that—
