The GridWise Alliance (GridWise) applauds your ongoing leadership on grid modernization issues, including on grid modernization demonstration projects. We are writing to express our strong appreciation and support for the introduction of your *Next Generation Electric Systems Act of 2019*. GridWise consists of electric utilities, information and communications technology equipment and service providers, national laboratories, academic institutions, Regional Transmission Operators (RTOs) and Independent System Operators (ISOs), and more.<sup>1</sup>
